- 1. Determine the number of seats on the council.
  - °Currently there are 10 parent seats on the council (3 continuing seats, 3 expired seats (to be filled by the election), and 4 vacated seats)
- 2. Decide how many of the vacated seats to retain and whether to open additional seats.

  •Move for equal number of seats that expire each year, close some of the vacated seats (which have one year left of the term) and open new seats (which would have two years left)
- 3. Vote for council positions voted on by all present voting members of the council (including staff and newly elected parents).
- 4. Appointments to fill vacant seats.
  - •Nomination and a second from voting parent members and appointment by majority vote of the parent members (staff members do not participate in the appointment of parent members).
- 5. Appointments to leadership roles on the council.
  - °Council members nominate a parent member to serve as chair who should be confirmed by a second and majority vote (all voting members participate parents and staff). Council members nominate a staff member to serve as vice chair who should be confirmed by a second and majority vote (all voting members participate parents and staff).
- 6. Time turned over to new chair for remainder of meeting
- 7. Discuss bylaws and any changes to be made
- 8. Training for new and current council members
- 9. Review of & Timetable for Trustlands money (ie. Teacher surveys, reviewing data from last year's testing, school improvement plan, approve use of funds)
